All dogs must be current on all vaccines, including DHLPPC, Bordetella, and Rabies. Furthermore dogs must have had a negative heartworm test and fecal test done within the last year. They must be current on both heartworm prevention and flea prevention that has been purchased from a licensed veterinarian office. All cats must be current on all vaccines, including FVRCP, Feline Leukemia, Rabies, and Feline Bordetella. Cats must have also had a negative fecal test done within the past year. They must also be current on heartworm prevention and flea prevention that has been purchased for a licensed veterinarian office. Stop by today to take a tour of our boarding facility.

Bordetella a.k.a. "Kennel Cough"

Bordetella is commonly known as Kennel Cough. It is a common misconception that only dogs and cats that are in kennels can get it. Any dog or cat can get bordetella from anywhere because it is an airborne infection.
